

Some statistics (as of March 2024)

- Orbits the earth every 90 minutes (16 orbits per day) and travels the distance to the Moon and back every day.
- Up since Nov 2000.
- 279 individuals from 22 countries have visited the ISS.
- Longest visit was 665 days (Peggy Whitson Sept. 2, 2017).
- The living and working space is larger than a six-bedroom house, it has six sleeping quarters, two bathrooms, a gym, and a 360-degree view bay window).
- 109 metres long end to end.
- The solar panels are 109 metres long, longer than a Jumbo jet or an Airbus 380 wing.
