

# Email Crib sheet

## General notes

This is a WIP document and will be updated in due course

Most email servers (e.g. Gmail) keep deleted emails in a 'trash' folder for 30 days before finally removing them for ever, check your provider.

## iPhone or iPad

### Notes

- iPhone/iPad additionally creates an 'archive' folder for deleted items that you must delete yourself

Action	Method
Search	Pull down folder and search box appears.
Deleting a lot of emails	Click on select in a folder and chose the ones to delete
Creating a folder (mailbox)	In the list of folders click on edit and New mailbox
Moving a message to a folder	Click on the folder icon below the email
Inserting a photo in an email	Hold finger where you want photo and scroll to the right OR In photos click on share and select email
Saving a photo in an email	Click on the photo and select share > save image
Create or edit a rule (filter)	See the browser interface below

## Android Mail

Action	Method
Search	Click in search box at top of a list of emails
Deleting a lot of emails	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Long-press an email to select the ones you want to delete (see the tick),</li><li>• Tap the trash icon to move them to the trash.</li></ul>
Creating a folder (mailbox)	Only possible in the web interface – see below
Moving a message to a folder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Display the email you want to move</li><li>• Click on the move to folder icon at top right</li><li>• Select the folder to move to</li></ul>
Inserting a photo in an email	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Start a new email,</li><li>• Tap the paperclip icon (often labelled "Attach"),</li><li>• Select the photo from your gallery or files.</li></ul>
Saving a photo in an email	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Click on to your gallery</li></ul>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	See the browser interface below

## Windows Mail

<b>Action</b>	<b>Method</b>
Search	Search box at top of screen
Deleting a lot of emails	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Click on the select box above the list of emails in a folder</li><li>• Select the ones to delete</li><li>• Click on the trash can</li></ul>
Creating a folder (mailbox)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scroll down the list of folders to the parent where you want a subfolder</li><li>• Click on the three dots</li><li>• Click Create new sub label</li></ul>
Moving a message to a folder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open the email</li><li>• Click on the Move to icon</li><li>• Chose a folder</li></ul> <p>You can also create a folder here. Multiple ones can be moved using the select dialogue described above for delete.</p>
Inserting a photo in an email	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create a new email</li><li>• Click on the insert tab at the top of the page</li><li>• Pick pictures</li></ul>
Saving a photo in an email	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open the email</li><li>• Click on the down arrow at the bottom of the picture</li><li>• Chose save as and select a location</li></ul>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	See the browser interface below

## Mac Mail

<b>Action</b>	<b>Method</b>
Search	Use search box (top right)
Deleting a lot of emails	Use search, then wipe over the ones to delete>right click and select delete
Creating a folder (mailbox)	Right click on the parent mailbox and select new mailbox
Moving a message to a folder	Drag and drop
Inserting a photo in an email	Drag and drop into the email OR Click on photo icon (top right)
Saving a photo in an email	Drag and drop image into Photos app
Create or edit a rule (filter)	See the browser interface below

Action	Method
Go to URL	<a href="https://www.icloud.com/mail/">https://www.icloud.com/mail/</a>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	Click on the gear icon above the list of mailboxes

### Gmail

Action	Method
Go to URL	<a href="https://mail.google.com/mail/">https://mail.google.com/mail/</a>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open an email that you want to filter</li><li>• Click on the 3 dots for more</li><li>• Click <b>Filter messages like these.</b></li><li>• Click next</li><li>• Click on skip inbox and select destination folder</li></ul>
Create a folder (Label)	Scroll down the list of folders to the parent where you want a subfolder Click on the three dots Click Add sub label

### Yahoo

Action	Method
Go to URL	<a href="https://yahoo.com">https://yahoo.com</a>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open an email that you want to filter</li><li>• Click on 3 dots for more, then select filter messages like this</li></ul>

### Hotmail

Action	Method
Go to URL	<a href="https://outlooklive.com">https://outlooklive.com</a>
Create or edit a rule (filter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open an email that you want to filter</li><li>• Click on 3 dots for more, then select Advanced actions &gt; Create rule</li></ul>
