## On-line magazines

Both of these offer a bundle of magazines to be viewed electronically on any device (PC, Mac, tablet, Phone) for about £10/month

- Kindle unlimited includes many more magazines, comics and millions of books (including audible books)


# Facebook Vs Web Page

- Many shops, pubs and villages have Facebook pages because these are free, and easy to set up, however they are often not maintained, and don't lend themselves to some outlets, e.g. many restaurants have Facebook pages where its almost impossible to find the menu.  
e.g. Stoke Ash white Horse
- On the other hand a Web site can easily be set up that reflects the organisations "brand". The web site may include links to other features like a booking system. They are also often not maintained regularly.

- For pubs and restaurants it may be better to start with Tripadvisor for a more independent view.

# What can you put in a phone wallet?

You can put the following in a phone wallet;

- Nearly all payment cards (Debit or Credit)
- Identification Cards e.g. Covid pass,
- Rail tickets e.g. Greater Anglia, SNCF
- Event or movie tickets
- Loyalty and gift cards e.g. Waitrose , Tesco, Nectar, M&S, Boots



# What can't you put in a phone wallet?

You cannot put the following in a phone wallet;

- Senior railcard
- Oyster Card
- Aldi Loyalty Card
- Greggs Loyalty Card
- Superdrug Loyalty Card
- Holland & Barrett Loyalty Card

# How do you get a card or ticket into the wallet

- Payments cards;
  - Open the wallet and click on '+' on iPhone or 'Add to Wallet' on Android. Select Debit or Credit, then you can use your phone's camera to read the details off the card. Complete the form and follow the instructions to get yourself verified by the bank.
- Other cards or tickets;
  - Click on the appropriate logo when in the Shops App or an email from them.
