Overview

- A printer puts documents onto paper, a scanner takes a photograph of a document
- Printers can print letters, photos, forms
- They connect by cable or Wi-Fi
- They work with computers, laptops, tablets and phones

Popular domestic types of printer/scanner

- Inkjet (good for photos)
- Laser (good for text, cheaper long term)
- All-in-one (print, scan, copy)
- Popular brands include:
 - HP
 - Canon
 - Epson
 - Brother

Choosing a printer

- Select quality you want inkjet or laser, the more dots per inch, the better photographs will be rendered.
- Remember you will probably spend more on the ink than the printer
- Non branded inks are pretty good nowadays, but more likely to clog, needing a head clean, if left for long times without use than branded inks.
- It doesn't cost much more to have an integrated scanner

The Most Common Problems

- Printer won't print
- Paper jam
- Ink has run out
- Printer says "Offline"
- Scanner not detected
- Poor print quality

Problem 1: Printer Won't Print

- Check it is switched on
- Check the plug and socket
- Make sure paper is loaded
- Look for error lights

Tip: Turn it off, wait 30 seconds, then turn it back on.

Printer Says “Offline”

- Check Wi-Fi connection, try with a test page.
- Restart your router
- Restart your computer
- Set printer as “Default Printer”

This solves many issues.

Fixing Paper Jams

This very much depends on the model of your printer, but usually you have to;

- Turn the printer off
- Open all access panels
- Gently pull paper out slowly - Do not force it
- If torn, remove all small pieces.

Ink or Toner Problems 1 of 2

If prints are missing colours, or not all areas are printed, this is probably an ink or toner problem;

- Check ink levels
- Replace empty cartridges
- Ensure cartridges click into place
- Use correct ink model number

Ink or Toner Problems 2 of 2

If ink level is OK but it still misses part of the print, find the Printers Utilities page and initiate head cleaning then print a test page. You may need to do this more than once.

- Windows
 - Settings->Printers and Scanners
 - Look for a tab labeled Maintenance, Utility, or Service.
- Mac
 - System Settings->Printers and Scanners->select printer and printer queue
 - Right click on the printer and select Printer info

Always keep spare ink at home.

Wifi Problems

- Is Wi-Fi working on other devices?
- Does the printer work via a cable?
- Move printer closer to router, note if you have changed your router or network, you will need to reflect the new network on your printer
- Reconnect printer to Wi-Fi
- Restart both router and printer

Common pointer error messages

- Common messages:
 - “Out of Paper”
 - “Low Ink”
 - “Door Open”
 - “Paper Jam”

Read message carefully — some printers take you through step-by-step on how to fix the problem.

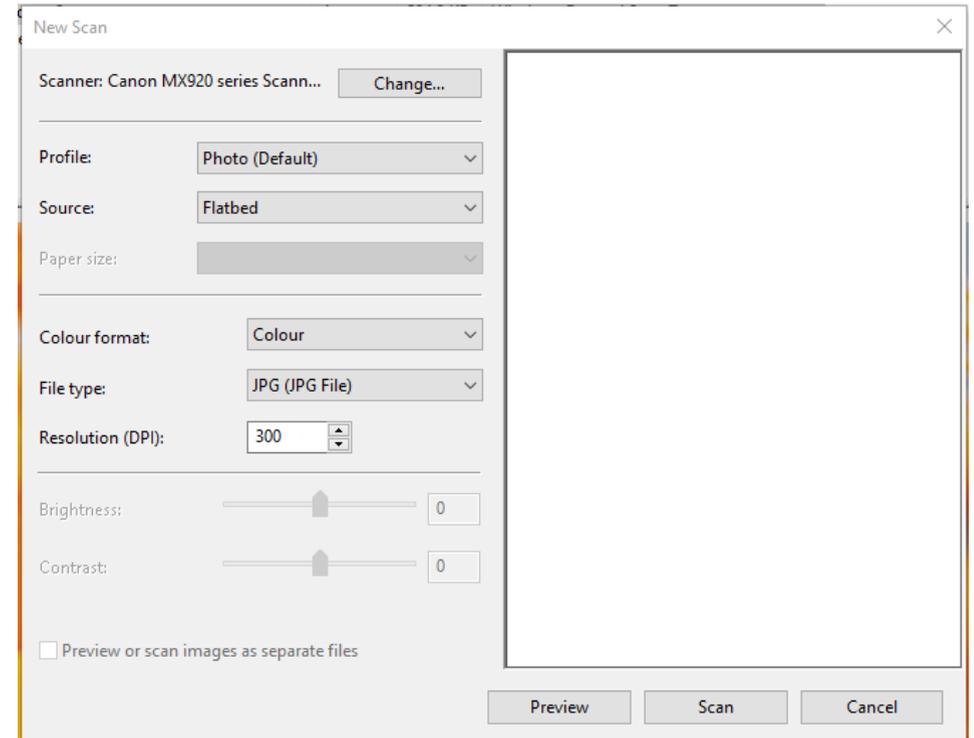

Which tool to use?

- Your scanner will probably come with a scanning application, if not, you can use the built in Microsoft Fax and Scan app
- There are a few good third party apps both free and paid
 - VueScan is the Rolls Royce scanning app, it costs £67 it has all the features you could want and works well with older scanners
 - Not Another PDF Scanner 2 - NAPS2 <https://www.naps2.com/> (Windows only) is a simple, free app with better features than the windows Fax and Scan
- In many cases you get just as good results with your phone!

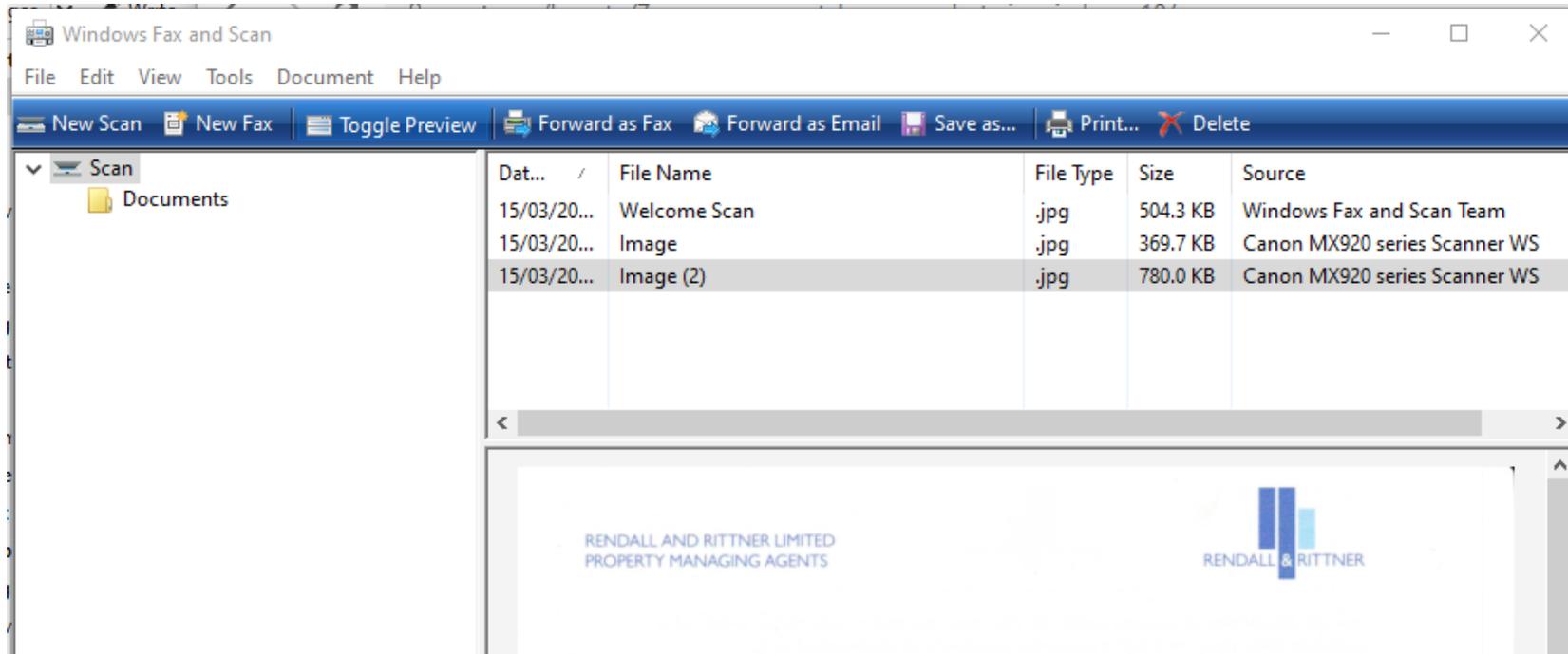
How to scan using the Microsoft Fax and Scan app

- Type scan in the search box at the bottom left of the screen and select the Windows Fax and Scan application
- Click scan on the bottom left followed by new scan at the top left
- A pop-up like this will appear, select options, then Preview. Select the area you want to scan and then press Scan



Microsoft Fax and scan app

- Once the image has been scanned it is put into Documents\Scanned Documents

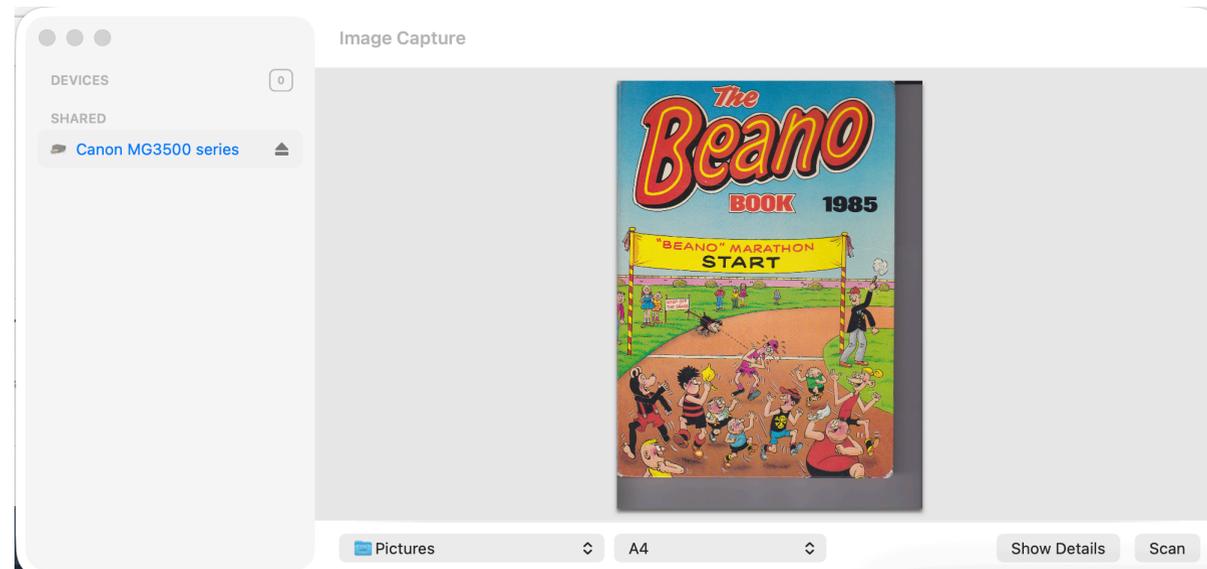


Limitations of Microsoft Fax and Scan

- Microsoft Scan and Fax is fine for simple scans but has several limitations;
 - Only really good for single page scans
 - No Optical Character Recognition (OCR)
 - No direct PDF support
 - Older scanners are not supported

Scanning on a Mac

- Run the Image Capture app
- Select your scanner on the left,
- Adjust settings (size, folder), and Click “Scan”.
